That is a conscious choice.


The Academy offers students a substantive framework.

The Academy guarantees the quality through the testing and assessment of the professional experience..










# 840 hours practice a year





# Why hand in practice forms?

Filling out and handing in the practice forms is compulsory in order to assess the professional experience and to assign the matching credits

Practice form gives the Academy quantitative information

Assessment at the end of the year give the Academy qualitative information

## When to hand in?

### **Hand in your practice form:**

- 1. At the start of every academic year.
- 2. In the event of a change of employer
- 3. For renewal / extension of an existing contract with the same employer




